What you should know:

Children are Welcome

Children under 3 years of age are accommodated at no charge. Children from 3 to 12 years of age may share with adults at 50% of the adult rate. Maximum of 2 children per room. Children from 12 years and older, will be charged the full adult rate whether sharing with parents or staying in a separate unit. Babysitting facilities are offered at a nominal extra charge. Prior notice to request this service is essential. Game drives and nature walks can be tailor made for children.

Dietary Requirements

Please inform the reservations office in advance should any special dietary needs be required.

Medical Conditions

Prior to arrival, guests should notify the reservations office of any pre-existing medical conditions. This includes any allergies etc. The reservations office should be informed in advance of any physical disabilities. This is essential as elephant access may not be possible and appropriate accommodation and vehicle seating facilities are limited.

Malaria

As the Eastern Cape is malaria-free, prophylactics are not necessary.

Indemnity

On arrival guests are requested to sign our standard indemnity form.

Transfers

Transfers are available at an extra cost.

- Adult rates are quoted per person per day, sharing in twin or king-size accommodation
- A single supplement of 50% applies
- 0 3 Year old children to share with parents at no extra charge
- 4 12 Year old children either sharing a room with their parents, or in a separate unit will be charged 50% of the normal rate

Payment and Cancellation Policy

- To secure your booking, payment should be made on receipt of invoice
- 25% of fee if cancellation less than 30 days prior to arrival
- 50% of fee if cancellation less than 15 days prior to arrival
- 100% of fee if cancellation less than 7 days prior to arrival
- Under no circumstances can the lodge refund or transfer unused bed-nights caused by cancellation due to flight or airport delays, sickness and any other unforeseen circumstances

Elephant Encounter / Walk

A once in a lifetime experience - at one with nature. Guests can enjoy an elephant encounter / walk through the diverse valleys, plains and forests of the bushveld, whilst delighting in the beauty of the flora and fauna.

Walk with, observe & feed our majestic giants, Thaba, Mukwa and Duma in their natural environment among the trees and grassland. Enjoy in-depth interpretation with their trained handlers who will share their specialized knowledge into their behaviour and the area's unique eco-system.

Walk with them through the bushveld, ravine and forest habitat. At the conclusion of the walk, enjoy rewarding the elephants with their favorite treats.

Child Policy: Children are allowed on the walk with a parent, accompanied by an elephant handler. Child rate is 50% of the adult price for children aged between 3-12 years. Children under 3 - no charge.

Duma is the most humble and endearing of the three, yet ironically also the dominant bull. He shows superior intelligence, pays attention during training and has mastered all the handlers' commands. All of which is done through a positive reinforcement reward system.

Mukwa the greedy one has a reputation for stealing feed from the other two elephants whenever he gets the chance. He is affectionately nick named 4X4 as he is the strongest of the trio and makes climbing the steep mountain slopes seem effortless.

Thaba has proven to be the exact opposite of his two bachelor companions and is a closed book, never showing his intentions, his big and all-knowing eyes not revealing a thing.

What to bring: We recommend that you note the following in order to maximize your comfort during your encounter / walk:

- Sunglasses
- Sun hat
- Long trousers / slacks
- Good walking shoes (running / tennis shoes are suitable)
- Warm jacket for the winter months (May to September)
- Light rain gear
- Sun block

Bird & Botany Guided walk

1 May 2021 - 30 April 2024 (per person)

Duration: 2hrs

As traversing the bush on foot provides an entirely new perception into nature's mysterious wonders, we offer a leisurely bush walk suited to young and old alike. The walking trails are conducted within our reserve and take place in the company of a knowledgeable guide. This valley bushveld region encompasses habitats ranging from semi-arid Karoo areas, across Fynbos-covered slopes which merge with impenetrable thickets and forests, extending into rolling grasslands which stretch all the way to the Sunshine Coast of the Eastern Cape. Blessed with this natural biodiversity the reserve is able to support a wide range of approximately 91 tree species, various birds of prey, canopy birds, song birds, nocturnal birds, ground birds and grassland birds.







Game Drive on our property 1 May 2021 - 30 April 2024 (per person)

Duration: 2hrs



Our experienced rangers create every opportunity to ensure exceptional viewing during your game drive on this 1000 hectare wildlife property. Excellent sightings, of amongst others, eland, waterbuck, blesbuck, wildebeest, giraffe and zebra can be enjoyed across the reserve's biomes which are made up of fynbos, sub topical thicket and forest. Our reserve is situated in the pristine valleys of the Zuurberg Mountains bordering the Greater Addo Elephant National Park, regarded as Southern Africa's most biologically diverse Park as it supports 5 of the 7 recognized biomes, or ecoregions of Southern Africa. Your guide will offer information on all wildlife, botany and also give you the historical background of the area.






Off our reserve: (Pre-booking essential)

Addo Elephant National Park

This is a private tour through the National Park with an accredited guide. Now the third largest national park in South Africa, Addo Elephant Park has expanded to conserve a wide diversity of biodiversity, landscapes, fauna and flora.

Stretching from the semi-arid Karoo area in the north around Darlington Dam, over the rugged Zuurberg Mountains, through the Sundays River valley and south to the coast between Sundays River mouth and Bushman's river mouth. Addo covers about 180 000 hectares (444 700 acres) and includes the Bird and St Croix Island groups.

This finely tuned ecosystem is sanctuary to over 450 elephants, Cape buffalo, a variety of antelope species as well as the unique flightless dung beetle, found almost exclusively in Addo.

- The park conserves no less than five of South Africa's seven biomes
- It is home to one of the densest African elephant populations on earth
- It is home to the unique flightless dung beetle
- It incorporates the largest coastal dune field in the southern hemisphere
- The park boasts the Big Seven, (elephant, black rhino, lion, buffalo, leopard, southern right whale and great white shark)
- It protects the world's largest Cape gannet breeding population on Bird Island
- This park offers some of the most spectacular elephant viewing in the world
- Antelope species abundant in the main game area of the park include red hartebeest, eland, kudu and bushbuck, whilst Gemsbok, black wildebeest, springbok, buffalo and black rhino are found in the arid nama-karoo area. The Burchell's zebra, Cape mountain zebra, spotted hyenas, mountain reedbuck, baboons, blue duiker, aardwolf and red rock rabbit are some of the other game species found in the Park

The guided Addo River Safari allows guests to explore a different side of Addo and view game and birds on the riverbank while you drift down some of the most scenic parts of the Sunday's River in a custom designed, comfortable and safe canoes (no paddling experience needed).

The popular Addo River Safari offers guests the best bird watching experience in the Eastern Cape, where one can find countless water birds, 7 different species of kingfisher and the chance of sighting the magnificent fish eagle.

The Custom canoes are ultra stable and provide excellent photographic opportunities to wildlife photographers- especially bird watching enthusiasts.

Schotia Safaris: Tooth & Claw Safari (per person)

Duration: 8 hrs

The Schotia Tooth & Claw Safari is a four hour guided game drive in an open Land Rover or Land Cruiser with a short refreshment and toilet break at the halfway point. After an amazing experience, where you will view more animals than you thought possible, enjoy a delicious dinner which is prepared over an open fire. Schotia tries to show guests as much as possible on a drive and concentrate on the popular sightings like Rhino, Buffalo, Elephant, Hippo, Giraffe and the King of the Beasts - Lions!! A short, spot lit night game drive providing the possibility of more nocturnal animals completes your experience as you return to the reception area.

Arrival from 14h30: Report to reception (sign indemnity; make sure bookings are correct etc.) Meet your guide/ranger. Enjoy a cup of tea/ coffee. Make sure you have all your cameras, batteries, jackets, binoculars etc. Please inform the office if you have any special requirements e.g. wheelchairs, frail, children, fears, allergies, dietary requirements etc. Please make sure that you have absolutely no fruit in any bag, handbag, packet or jacket pocket. The reason for this is that the elephants can smell food, whether open or closed and they will try to get it.


